Meeting Notes

Administrative Council met on September 15, 2016. Among items discussed were:

Consecration Sunday– Council voted to pay for the special catered dinner that will follow the Consecration Sunday service out of the Palmer Fund.

Parsonage issues were discussed. The leaks to the parsonage are mostly repaired. Flooding problem in church fellowship hall during heavy rains have not been addressed, as no bids have been received. Outdoor lights on old part of church that are not working are to be repaired or replaced. Ice/water machine is also being repaired.

Children's church now has 2 classes, as the amount of children coming has increased and resulted in the need to split into two groups. More help is needed, especially in the younger class. There will be a sign up sheet in the coffee area for helpers to sign up on a weekly basis. There are also plans in October to take the children to a corn maze. The board also voted to allow purchase of VBS material for next year, and approved purchase of Christmas gifts for older children's church class.

6. Waiting on quotes for sump pump pit in stair well to stop water entering the new basement.

7. Activity room and education wing needs stripped and waxed.
