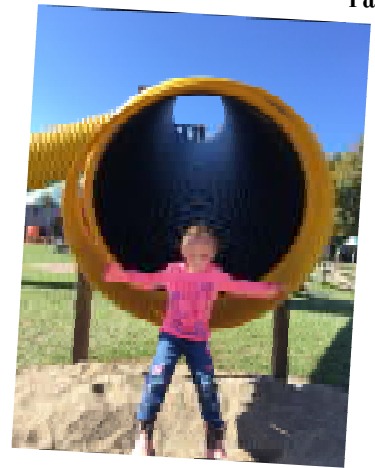
TRUSTEES MEETING
