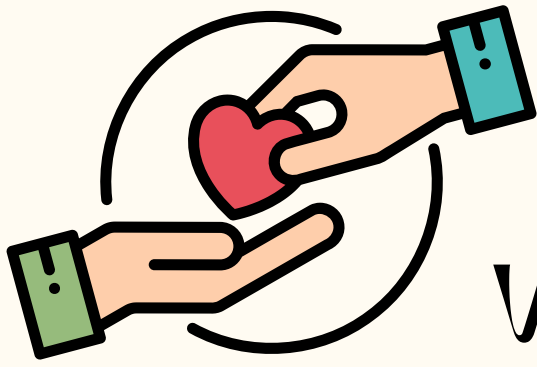

Sermon points

1. Staying in love with God is the third of John Wesley's three simple rules for Christian living. This rule emphasizes the importance of maintaining a deep, transformative relationship with God that shapes our actions and allows us to be channels of God's goodness in the world.
2. Jesus demonstrated perfect love through His actions, healing the sick, forgiving sinners, and sacrificing Himself for humanity. We are called to emulate this love in our own lives, both in our relationship with God and in our interactions with others.
3. To stay in love with God, Wesley recommended practicing spiritual disciplines like attending worship, participating in communion, studying scripture, and engaging in private prayer. These practices help us remain connected to God, hear His guidance, and grow in our faith.
4. Loving God often requires us to step out of our comfort zones and follow His will, even when it's challenging. By surrendering our own desires and trusting in God's plan, we open ourselves to unexpected blessings and spiritual growth.
5. The three simple rules - do good, do no harm, and stay in love with God - provide a practical framework for living out our Christian faith. By following these rules, we can better align our lives with God's will and become more effective witnesses of His love in the world.
