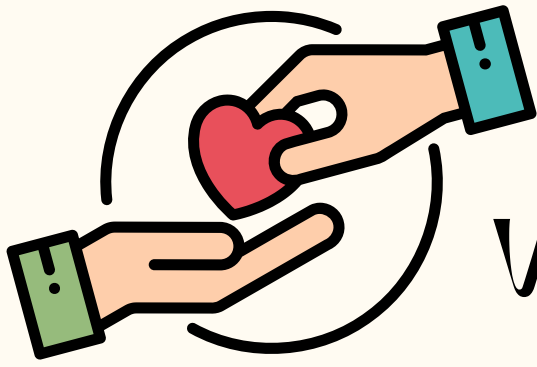

# Grow

## Sermon points

1. Isaiah's vision of peace challenges us to see beyond our current divisions and work towards harmony. We are called to be active builders of this "Peaceable Kingdom" in our daily lives, not just wait for it in the future.
2. John Wesley's three simple rules for Christian living provide practical guidance for navigating political discourse: do no harm, do good, and stay in love with God. These principles can help us engage in respectful dialogue and build bridges across ideological divides.
3. True compassion means entering into others' experiences and responding with love, even towards those with whom we disagree. By practicing compassion, we can create spaces for reconciliation and understanding, following examples like Daryl Davis who befriended KKK members.
4. Our ability to live harmoniously with others is directly tied to our relationship with God. Maintaining daily practices of prayer and scripture reading can ground us in God's love and vision for our world, especially during times of social and political tension.
5. As Christians, we are challenged to actively seek out and engage with those who hold different views. By praying for those we disagree with and making efforts to understand their perspectives, we can contribute to building a more peaceful and compassionate society.
