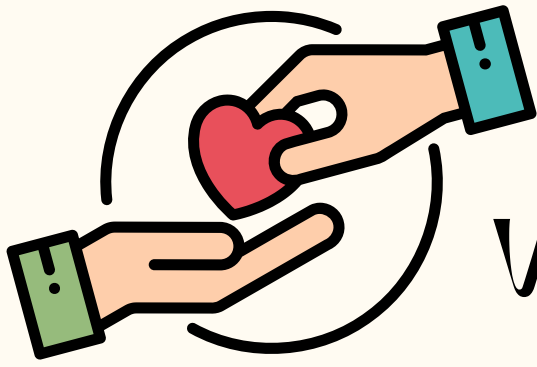

Sermon points

Does the Bible Apply to You?

Message presented to the Edgerton congregation by Karlyn McPike

- When Karlyn's young son was confused with a lesson in the bible (Matthew 18: 7-9), it was challenging to explain to this young child that the Bible is a special book that teaches us about God and how to live good lives. But some of the stories in the Bible are like big lessons or parables. They're written in a way to help us understand important ideas, not always exactly what happened. People over time have read the Bible and understood the messages in different ways, and that's why we talk about it, to help us learn what God wants us to know.
- The Lord is my Shepherd (23 Psalm) - the challenge of knowing who a shepherd is or what they do. In biblical times, the role of a shepherd was extremely important; he is responsible for caring for the sheep and keeping them safe, and even at times, giving their life to keep his sheep safe. In our lives, Jesus is the Shepherd, and he gave His life for His sheep.
- The Armor of God (Ephesians 6: 10-17) - physically wearing armor is not often heard of. But 2000 years ago, armor was a common sight, worn by the Roman soldiers on a regular basis. Paul writes about putting on the armor of God, not for a physical battle. He was preparing them for a spiritual battle so they could stand their ground against evil. Today, the full armor of God has never lost its power and is still relevant today and protects us.
- Our challenge today is to find those scriptures that you may not understand or possibly don't even like; go back to those passages and re-read them, study them, and see how they apply to your life.
