Grow Sermon points

- 1. God created us to be givers, not keepers. Our innate need for generosity is often challenged by the voices of fear and self-gratification, but as we grow in Christ, we can silence these voices and become more generous.
- 2. Generosity is a fruit of spiritual growth. As we allow the Holy Spirit to change us from the inside out, our focus shifts from pleasing ourselves to pleasing God and caring for others.
- 3. Tithing is a biblical principle that still applies today. While we're not bound by the Old Testament law, giving a tenth of our income to God remains a good guideline for Christians and is pleasing to Him.
- 4. When our income increases, our standard of giving should rise, not our standard of living. John Wesley exemplified this principle by maintaining his living expenses and increasing his charitable giving as his income grew.
- 5.Generosity blesses both the giver and the recipient. When we give generously to God and others, our hearts are filled with joy, and we often experience unexpected blessings in return
